1960's

In 1960, the Credit Committee approved 33 loans for a total of \$7,375.

In 1963 a telephone with the “new dial system” was installed. The installation charge was \$3.75 and monthly rental was \$4.75.

Term deposits were first offered in 1966.

The Credit Union's location moved 3 times during the 1960's.

Assets grew to \$135,866 at the end of 1969.
