1970's

In 1971 the credit union was approved as a cheque writing institution.

Mortgages were also first offered in 1971.



In 1974, the credit union approved the Big Horn Ram as its official logo, and it moved into its own building on the north end of Main Street, and proceeded to have 4 renovations before the end of the decade as its services and number of staff grew.

In 1976 Leslieville Credit Union amalgamated with the Rocky Mountain House & District Savings & Credit Union.

The credit union's first computer accounting system was introduced in 1976.

By 1979 the credit union employed 15 staff and had assets of over \$14,000,000.

Rodeo Week decorations are an annual tradition with the credit union. Staff always does a good job of decorating the branch and dressing up for the celebration.
