On January 18, 1944 eleven residents of Rocky Mountain House met to establish a credit union. Two months later the first executive was formed for Rocky Mountain House & District Savings & Credit Union:

Vice-President	J.H. Jones
Secretary/treasurer	T.H. Bucknall



Meetings and business were done in the Committee Room of the Co-op store. Loans were set up by appointment.

The first loan was in the amount of \$200 for weaner pigs.

Over the next couple of years most loans were for under \$50.
