Profit Share

Each year, Rocky Credit Union takes the total amount of interest that you paid on your mortgages and loans, and shares a portion back with you; set annually by our Board. Last year, we shared 12%.

Earning 12% in Profit Share equates to approximately one and a half months of your interest payments paid back to you! For a mortgage of \$500,000 at 4.19%, you'd receive \$2514 of cash back!

Charlotte Small Elementary School





RCU visited Charlotte Small Elementary School twice in April to present Financial Literacy workshops to the grade 4s and 5s. With the grade 4 class, our volunteers gave a 'More Than Money' presentation, which is all about basic money management. The class learned what a financial institution is and the different types, how to build a good budget, and a bit about running a business. Students got to come up with a fake business idea, and use it as a case scenario to understand profits and losses.

With the grade 5 class, our presenters gave an 'Our Business World' presentation. This program focused on exploring the job of an entrepreneur. The students learned about what it would be like to be a business owner, and what goes into running a successful business. They brainstormed their favourite products and reflected on why those inventions thrived.

Pioneer Middle School



Pioneer Middle School hosts an annual Speech Competition for the top students in each grade. RCU sent two of our staff to be guest judges for the competition! Each student presented their prepared speech, and then the grade 8 students had to deliver an impromptu speech for 1-2 minutes. The students were judged on their content,

delivery, and overall effectiveness of their speeches. There were many interesting topics, such as 'Service Dogs', 'Math', and 'Why Everyone Should Love Bread'. Overall, our guest-judge volunteers were very impressed with the public speaking skills of these grade 6, 7, and 8 students!

Scam of the Month: Device Takeovers

This scam starts when a person clicks on a malicious link that was sent to them. From there, even if you didn't enter any personal information, scammers are able to takeover your device, or mirror it back to their device. Changing your passwords is no use, because they can see everything happening on your screen. They will send themselves an e-Transfer, and you likely won't know that anything is happening until you discover missing funds. If you believe this (or any scam) has happened to you, contact all of your financial institutions and the RCMP.
